PROGRAM OVERVIEW

WHO? The mission of Johns Creek Beautification (JCB) is to enhance the well-being and natural beauty of our community by bringing people together through landscaping and public works of art.

WHAT? D4H is a community-wide planting program that began in 2019 as a way to promote CanCare Atlanta, a community of survivors who lift up and inspire cancer patients and caregivers through one-on-one support. JCB also honors and remembers our veterans with the goal of planting 58,000 daffodils near The Wall That Heals in Newtown Park.

WHEN? Fundraising and planning can occur year round. Daffodils are planted anytime from October 1st to December 1st. Daffodils bloom in early spring during the months of February and March.

WHERE? Daffodils are planted in community locations that include but are not limited to hospitals, houses of worship, schools, businesses, parks, senior communities, and subdivisions/HOAs.

WHY? The daffodil was chosen because it is a symbol of cancer survivorship and remembrance. The daffodil, jonquil, or narcissus, is known as the “Yellow Flower of Support” because it regenerates and reblooms each year.

HOW? Become a partner with JCB by donating \$450 for 1,000 bulbs and planting them. What a beautiful sight for the community to enjoy!

Your 1,000 bulbs will need a mostly sunny site of at least 200 square feet which is approximately the size of a large parking space.

2. SET YOUR DATES

- Order 1,000 bulbs and a Daffodils4Hope sign from JCB by donating \$450.
- Set your date(s) to prepare your flower bed.
- Set your date for planting your bulbs sometime between October 1st and December 1st.

3. PREPARE YOUR FLOWER BED

- To ensure successful blooms, your site needs to be cultivated with a shovel or tiller.
- Find a detailed planting guide on the website.

4. PLANT YOUR BULBS

- Recruit your volunteers from anyone who can put on a pair of gloves and wants to dig in the dirt.
- Instruct your volunteers to plant each bulb 4" – 6" deep and space them 6" apart, pointy end up.
- Proudly display the Daffodils4Hope sign in your flower bed to show your recognition and a support for CanCare and our veterans.
- Celebrate and enjoy your blooms next spring and for years to come!
- Increase the smiles in our community by adding more bulbs each year!
